WHEREAS, the Clinton Township Board of Education transmitted an official copy of the defeated budget and required documentation to the municipal clerk of the Township of Clinton on April 19, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, representatives of the Clinton Township Board of Education met with representatives of the Clinton Township Committee on May 8, 2007, May 10, 2007 and with the full Board and Council on May 14, 2007 for the purpose of discussing the election defeat; and,

WHEREAS, careful consideration has been given by the Township to the information received from the Board of Education, and the discussion which ensued, with a view toward providing a thorough and efficient education of the Clinton Township School; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to acknowledge that the 2007/2008 budget as described above results in a general fund tax levy in the amount of \$21,122,013, and a debt service tax levy in the amount of \$2,717,581.

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with Board of Education Policy No. 9250, "Expenses" the maximum travel allowance for the 2007/2008 school year shall be established at \$100,000.*

Dr. Schwartz commented that the \$1.5 million reduction is outrageous and expressed concern over the elimination of the Assistant Principal position.

Mr. Roskoski noted that the CTSD staff will need to assume additional responsibilities to ensure that our students remain safe.

Mr. Kaplan remarked that he is dissatisfied with the process.

Mr. Dincuff observed that 4 districts in Hunterdon County had their defeated budgets fully restored by their governing bodies.
