Open Public Meetings Act – Establish Meeting Dates, Time and Place

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Clinton Township Board of Education, pursuant to Chapter 231, PAL. (Open Public Meetings Act) does hereby proclaim the public meetings of the Board of Education will be held in the Clinton Township Middle School Auditorium, 34 Grayrock Road, Clinton NJ 08809 at 7:30 p.m., as set forth below unless indicated otherwise;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the purpose of the Regular Meetings shall be the normal conduct of business of the Board of Education and any other items brought to the Board's attention by the Board Members, Board Attorney, Superintendent and Business Administrator/Board Secretary;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Education does hereby designate the Hunterdon Democrat, Hunterdon Review and The Express-Times as official newspapers to receive notices of meetings;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Education hereby approves that notices of meetings of the Board of Education will be posted in the Clinton Township Board of Education Administration Office, each Clinton Township School, posted on the District website and filed with the Clerk of Clinton Township;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Education reserves the right to adjourn or recess a meeting at any time to discuss such matters that may be considered in closed session. However, the Board will first adopt a resolution describing as specifically as possible the nature of the subject to be discussed without undermining the need for confidentiality the estimated

length of the executive session, and, as precisely as possible, the time and circumstances under which disclosure to the public will be made;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, in order to conduct its meetings properly and efficiently, the Board shall require the following procedures pertaining to public participation at Board meetings:

- O Any individual desiring to speak shall give his or her name, address, and the group, if any, that is represented.
- O The presentation shall be as brief as possible but no more than three (3) minutes per individual.
- O The Board vests in its president, or other presiding officer, authority to terminate the remarks of any individual if he/she deems it in the best interest of those present to do so, and

**WHEREAS** 18A:18A-37,c. provides that all contracts that are in the aggregate less than 15% of the bid threshold (Currently \$5,400) may be awarded by the purchasing agent without soliciting competitive quotations if so authorized by board resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Clinton Township Board of Education, pursuant to the statutes cited above hereby appoints Anthony Juskiewicz, as its duly authorized purchasing agent and is duly assigned the authority, responsibility and accountability for the purchasing activity of the Clinton Township Board of Education; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Anthony Juskiewicz is hereby authorized to award contracts on behalf of the Clinton Township Board of Education that are in the aggregate less than 15% of the bid threshold (Currently \$5,400) without soliciting competitive quotations; and
