What is the HIB Self-Assessment?

1. The Commissioner of Education is required to grade each public school and school district's efforts to implement the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act.
2. Each school, through its School Safety/Climate Team (SS/SCT) evaluated the implementation of the ABR from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 using the Self-Assessment.
3. The Self-Assessment tool includes eight core elements that address all of the ABR requirements for schools.
4. SS/SCTs assigned a rating for each indicator based on criteria and available documentation.



Overview of Activities to Fulfill Requirements of the School Self-Assessment Program to Determine Grades under ABBR

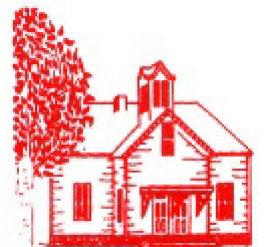
- SST completed the Self-Assessment in June assigning a rating for each indicator based on criteria and documentation.
- BOE presentation & submission to NJDOE prior to 9/30/17
- NJDOE will review data, create and issue school and district grade reports during the 17-18 school year
- Official grade reports will be reviewed at a public BOE meeting after receiving the official Grade Report from NJDOE
- Official Grade Reports will be posted on website within 10 days of receiving official Grade Report from NJDOE



Using the Self-Assessment

Divided into 8 core elements

1. HIB Programs, Approaches and Other Initiatives
2. Training on HIB Policy
3. Other Staff Instruction & Training
4. Curriculum & Instruction on HIB
5. HIB Personnel
6. HIB Incident Reporting Procedures
7. HIB Investigation Procedures
8. HIB Reporting



Using the Self-Assessment

- Rating scale with 4 categories

0 Does Not Meet the Requirements

1 Partially Meets the Requirements

2 Meets All Requirements

3 Exceeds the Requirements
