September Meeting Review

The Clinton Township Board of Education has three standing committees. They are Facilities and Finance, Personnel, and Policy and Curriculum. Below you will find the highlights of each committee report from the September 2018 Board meeting.

Superintendent's Report

- August enrollment was 1,219 students.
- Remediation of Mold Presentation

Facilities and Finance Committee

- Approved the payment of bills in the amount of \$1,652,532.17.
- Accepts with appreciation the donation by HC ESC of Kindergarten Bus for the first time rides during the Open House Visit to PMG on August 30th.
- Accepts with appreciation, a total of \$2,625 in STEM grants from Exxon Mobil Corporation for the 2018/19 school year.
- Approved the renewal and technology purchases.
- Approved 77 out of district professional development programs for district staff.
- Approved the payment of air quality testing at PMG and CTMS – do not exceed \$15K to LEW Corporation.

- Approved the payment to IRS Company for emergent services rendered to remediate Air Quality issues identified at PMG in an amount not exceed \$65K.
- Approved the purchase of Bulletin Boards for the 3rd and 4th grade hallways to exhibit students work at a cost not to exceed \$6K

Personnel Committee

- Approved the employment of new lunch room aide, and substitute nurse aides.
- Approved individual staff members to serve as Co-Curricular Advisors or Coaches at CTMS for the 2018/19 school year.
- Accepts with regret the retirement of Giusseppe Turco.
- Approved staff members to serve in the role of mentoring for new staff members.
- Approved staff members to be chaperones for the CTMS events.
- Approved one maternity leave.

Policy and Curriculum Committee

- Approved a four-day Responsive Classroom in-district training.
- Approved a field trip for 6th graders from CTMS to RVS to work on the garden.

Negotiations Update

 The Board and CTEA both agreed to take the next step in negotiations and enter into Fact Finding. A Fact Finder has been assigned and both parties are waiting for a date to be agreed on.
