## June Meeting Review

The Clinton Township Board of Education has three standing committees. They are Facilities and Finance, Personnel, and Policy and Curriculum. Below you will find the highlights of each committee report from the June 2018 Board meeting.

### Superintendent's Report

- June enrollment was 1,275 students.
- Reviewed recent questions and answers from parents regarding the district's [reorganization](#).

### Facilities and Finance Committee

- Authorized payment of bills for \$4,141,415.13.
- Approved Paramount Facility Management Solutions for the district's reorganization moves.
- Approved the hiring of a new auditing firm, Nisivoccia, LLP for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.
- Accepted a grant from the Clinton Township Foundation for Education Excellence for \$14,500.
- Approved the request for graduate work from six staff members.

### Personnel Committee

- Accepted the recommendation of the Superintendent for an Interim School Business Administrator/Board Secretary through December 31, 2018.
- Accepted the recommendation of the Superintendent for staffing placements for the 2018-2019 school year.

- Accepted the recommendation of the Superintendent for ESY staffing.
- Accepted the recommendation of the Superintendent for teaching staff members to write curriculum for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Approved a job description for the [Director of Special Projects – Transition](#).
- Accepted the resignation of Sue High, effective December 31, 2018.

### Policy and Curriculum Committee

- Approved the submission of submissions of the Exxon Mobil Corporation grant application for STEM projects, in the total amount of \$4,081.16.
- Approved the Master Services agreement with Johns Hopkins University's Center for Talented Youth for the 2018/19 school year.
- Approved the initial adoption of the K-6 math, 6-8 science and K-5 ELA curricula to align with the current state standards, and to be implemented in the beginning of the 2018-19 school year.
