

## **6. Why does the administrators' contract always negotiate so much faster than with the CTEA?**

- The last negotiation that took place with the Board and the Clinton Township Administrator's Association (CTAA) (Directors, supervisors, principals and assistant principals) took a little over one year to settle.
- The CTAA is a much smaller bargaining unit with less than 10 employees.
  - The CTEA has approximately 206 members.
- The most recent contract discussions were resolved after one meeting with the help of a mediator.
