Financial summary

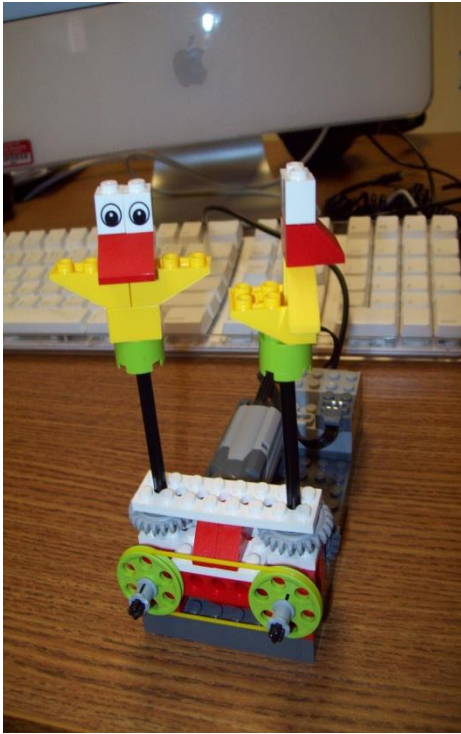
The foundation is a 501(c) (3) tax-exempt organization. Below is the summary for fiscal year July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
