

Clinton Township School District Standard Transportation Appeals Process Cul-de-Sacs Only

Standard Appeal Process

To make an appeal to the district for a bus to travel down a particular cul-de-sac to pick-up and drop-off your child or children, you must write a letter and send it to the district board office via certified mail.

Please include the following Information in your appeal letter;

1. Your name
2. Street address
3. Home phone number
4. Cell phone number
5. E-mail address
6. Child or children's name
7. Clinton Township school children attend
8. Cul-de-sac intersection
9. State reason(s) why the bus should travel down your cul-de-sac

Appeals will be accepted up until five days after notification of district bus routes are released to district families for the upcoming academic year. E-mails will not be accepted as a means to submit an appeal to the district office.

All appeal letters will be reviewed by the transportation review board that includes; the district transportation liaison, a district hired transportation consultant and the business administrator. All appeals will be reviewed under Policy 8600 and Regulation 8600. The district's transportation review board will provide a response to the individual who submitted an appeal in approximately two weeks after the appeal is received by the transportation department.

An individual that files an appeal will be notified via certified mail of the decision made by the district transportation review board within 14 days from when the appeal is received by the district office. The decision made by the district is final.
