REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

In addition to the monthly report on pupil enrollment, Dr. Nastus reported on the Clinton Township Senior's tour of the Clinton Township School District. Dr. Nastus read a thank you note from Senior Group representative Patty Schickedanz and a letter of congratulations on the opening of the Clinton Township Middle School from Acting County Superintendent Frank Dragotta.

Dr. Nastus presented the 2007/2008 Clinton Township School District Electronic Violence and Vandalism Report. Mr. Dincuff commended the administration, staff and guidance counselors for the outstanding achievement in the low number of incidents.

Action 08-147: RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:17-46, N.J.A.C. and N.J.A.C. 6A:16-5.3(f); require that at a public hearing each year, the superintendent of schools provide a report to the board of education on all acts of violence and vandalism which occurred in the school district during the previous school year;

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:36-5.1 and N.J.A.C. 6A:16-5.2 designates October 15-19, 2007 as School Violence Awareness Week in the state of New Jersey.

WHEREAS, the Clinton Township School District has observed this week by organizing activities to prevent school violence, including, but not limited to, age appropriate opportunities for student discussion on conflict resolution, issues of student diversity and tolerance;

WHEREAS, law enforcement personnel were invited to join members of the teaching staff in the discussions;

WHEREAS, programs designated to help recognize warning signs of school violence and to instruct on recommended conduct during an incident of school violence were provided for school employees;

WHEREAS, this public hearing is specifically conducted to fulfill the district's legal obligation to present school violence and vandalism information to the public and to conduct public hearings on the violence and vandalism report;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:17-46 and N.J.A.C. 6A:16-5.3(a) 4, the Superintendent has provided a presentation to the board of education at the public hearing on all acts of violence and vandalism which occurred during the previous school year, including a report on the district's verified violence and vandalism data submitted under the Electronic Violence and Vandalism Reporting System (EVVRS) to the NJDOE for the previous school year (2006- 2007).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education accepts the Superintendent's public report on Violence and Vandalism.

WHEREAS the required maintenance activities as listed in the attached document for the various school facilities of the Clinton Township School District are consistent with these requirements, and

WHEREAS all past and planned activities are reasonable to keep school facilities open and safe for use or in their original condition and to keep their system warranties valid,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton Township School District hereby authorizes the School Business Administrator to submit the attached Comprehensive Maintenance Plan for the Clinton Township School District in compliance with Department of Education requirements. Motion by R. Straight, seconded by T. Roskoski. On a roll call vote resolution was ADOPTED as follows: ayes, 7; nays, 0.

WHEREAS the Clinton Township Board of Education has 3 projects identified in its 5-year Long Range Facility Plan that have not been initiated or advanced; and,

WHEREAS the 3 projects have an estimated cost over the 5-year period of \$4,224,000; and,

WHEREAS it is estimated that the district may be eligible for debt service or EDA Grant funds for these projects in the amount of \$1,689,600. Accordingly the estimated local share of these projects is \$2,534,400; and,

WHEREAS the local share in the amount of \$2,534,400 represents the maximum amount the Clinton Township School District may deposit in capital reserve for the 2007/2008 school year;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton Township School District approves this statement as "Addendum A" and authorizes its submission to the Hunterdon County Department of Education as part of the 2007 QAAR. Resolution to Restore the Principle of Majority Rule in the State of New Jersey as it Pertains to Special Budget Questions in School Board Annual Elections

Whereas, New Jersey Public School Districts face increasing budgetary challenges to maintain effective and high quality educational programs, and

Whereas, greater budgetary constraints (caps) imposed by recent legislation (Assembly Bill A1 and formally known as P.L. 2007, c.62) force many school districts to present high quality educational programs to district voters by means of special questions, and

Whereas, P.L. 2007, c.62 imposes an unprecedented 60% majority vote requirement for a special question to be successful and further declares that school districts have no right of appeal to the local municipality or the Commissioner of Education should such questions fail, and

Whereas, low voter turnout (often less than 15%) for school budgetary questions often means that success or failure is often based on very low margins, and

Whereas, this requirement violates all principles of majority rule and gives those persons who vote in the negative greater voice and control in their respective communities,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Clinton Township Board of Education requests its legislative representatives and Governor Jon Corzine to amend Chapter 62 to eliminate the provision of a super-majority (60%) vote for school district special questions and restore the principle of “one person, one vote” in the State of New Jersey, and

Be It Further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be sent to our local legislative representatives in the General Assembly and Senate, the Governor of the State of New Jersey, and to the New Jersey School Board's Association.
