President Dincuff stated that he would be starting future board meetings with a reading from a specific item from the School Board Code of Ethics and then briefly discuss the meaning of the passage. He requested that Donna Gregory at the June Board Meeting read a passage from the Code of Ethics and lead a brief discussion on its meaning.

### **REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS**

#### Enrollment and Suspension

Mr. Fyffe reported that the district has received notification from the Commissioner of Education regarding the QSAC evaluation. The district has been judged to be a "high performing district."

Mr. Fyffe reported that on May 6<sup>th</sup> Round Valley students competed in a Reading Olympics competition. All 7 Round Valley teams earned First Place ribbons and the Spying Spiders (Grade 6) earned the top score for the competition. Mrs. Lester was the advisor for the students and is to be commended for her work.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Discussion and final adoption of the 2009-2010 Budget.

Grace Hoefig reported, that as Board Liaison to the Clinton Township Council, she attended the May 13, 2009 meeting of the Council where they passed a resolution reducing the 2009-2010 budget by \$270,000. She reported to the Council on the meetings and discussions that were held prior to the Council's action.

Mark Kaplan then presented a resolution listing the line items that would be reduced as a result of the action of the Township Council and the revenue line that would be increased.

### **Action 09-511 RESOLUTION TO APPROVE 2009/2010 TAX LEVY CERTIFICATION**

*WHEREAS, representatives of the Clinton Township Board of Education met with representatives of the Clinton Township Committee on April 27 and May 11, 2009 for the purpose of discussing the election defeat; and,*

*WHEREAS, careful consideration has been given by the Township to the information received from the Board of Education, and the discussion which ensued, with a view toward providing a thorough and efficient education of the Clinton Township School; and,*

- Mr. and Mrs. Bucher addressed the Board of Education regarding a student discipline matter involving their daughters while riding the school bus. They claimed that it was a matter of sexual harassment and that the district's response has been lacking. They recommended the district institute training programs and develop a student handbook outlining the penalties for sexual harassment.
- Several other members of the audience addressed the Board regarding the incident involving the Bucher's children and expressed their dismay with the response of the administration.
- Nick Corcodilos asked the following questions of the Board of Education:

-What was the reason for giving the new school business administrator a salary of \$125,000 when she was making approximately \$91,000 in her old district?

-He questioned the use of the funds for salaries from the Interlocal Agreement with Lebanon Borough.

-He inquired as to the reasoning the Board opted to defer one-half of the PERS pension payment.

Responses were given to all three inquiries.

- Rachel McLaughlin inquired about an agenda item and where she could get a copy of the agenda.
- Several other members of the audience related their children's experience riding the school bus and the lack of discipline on the bus. They recommended that parent's and children sign a contract to ride a bus.

Energy Audit – Gene Schaedel presented a short report on the BPU program to provide energy audits for school districts in New Jersey. After an application process and approval by the BPU, the district must solicit proposals from five firms authorized to complete the audits. Once approved and the audit completed the BPU will reimburse school districts 75% of the cost of the audit. If the district implements projects identified in the audit that would result in reduced energy consumption within one year of the report then the BPU would reimburse the school district the remaining 25% of the audit. Mr. Schaedel indicated that he would investigate this program further and report back his findings.
