Clinton Township School District Families:

The Clinton Township School District is now able to provide free lunches 7 days a week for all Clinton Township School District students through December 31, 2020. This is thanks to a program funded by the United States Department of Agriculture and will help families and the district financially.

Beginning on Monday, October 19, a “Grab & Go” bagged lunch will be available for each student to bring home upon dismissal. These lunches are food-safe meals packed cold that must be stored under refrigeration. There will no longer be a “Place an Order” option through December 31, 2020. A free “Grab-&-Go” lunch will automatically be offered to each student. Students have the option to decline the “Grab-&-Go” lunch. Please remind your child(ren) that eating is not permitted on the bus in an effort to maintain sanitary conditions.

The lunch distribution schedule will be as follows:

- A-Cohort: 2 lunches will be distributed on Tuesday and 5 on Thursday
- B-Cohort: 2 lunches will be distributed on Wednesday and 5 on Friday
- C/Virtual Cohort: Pickup 7 lunches on Mondays at CTMS from 11:30 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Your child’s allergies should have already been reported to the school for this school year. If you have not yet reported your child’s allergies to the school, please contact your child’s school nurse as soon as practicable.

If you wish to opt-out, please contact your child’s school.
